Affirmative Consent to Political Contribution: Section 55(6) of the Michigan Campaign Finance Act provides that a corporation, a joint stock company, a domestic dependent sovereign, or a labor organization "may solicit or obtain contributions for a separate segregated fund established on an automatic basis, including but not limited to a payroll deduction plan, only if the individual who is contributing to the fund affirmatively consents to the contribution." Contributions to the state PAC are not tax deductible. Contributions to state PAC are completely voluntary and will be used for political purposes. You have the right to refuse to participate without any reprisal.
