Traditional rooms: \$539.00 per room, based on double occupancy

Deluxe rooms: \$629.00 per room, based on double occupancy

Note: Traditional rooms will sleep up to 4 people, deluxe rooms sleep up to 4 people and have a view of the water, premium rooms sleep up to 5 people and have a view of the water.

These rates include two nights lodging, breakfast each morning, Shepler's ferry service and one hour bike rental. Reservations must be made before July 3, 2019 to qualify for the conference discount. At time of reservation the two nights deposit will be required. Any requests for special room arrangements must be made at time of reservation.
