Note: Traditional rooms will sleep up to 4 people, deluxe rooms sleep up to 2 people (only one bed) and have a view of the water, premium rooms sleep up to 5 people and have a view of the water. Please add 6% state tax, 8% hotel levy and 3% tourism assessment to the above rates.

These rates include two nights lodging, breakfast each morning, and round trip Shepler's ferry service. <u>Reservations must be made before July 5, 2022, to qualify</u> <u>for the conference discount.</u> At time of reservation the two nights deposit will be required. We are living and leading in a VUCA world (volatility, uncertainty, complexity, and ambiguity) – and that doesn't look like it's going to change anytime soon.
